Sections I & II of the Handbook) are best for my/our Student(s). Lincoln’s philosophy and practices may not be suitable for every child; No student will be allowed to disrupt the education of other students; Student(s) are expected to meet Handbook attendance policy by attending school each school day, arriving promptly and remaining throughout the scheduled hours, except for limited, excusable absences. Parents must make every attempt to schedule medical appointments and vacations outside of school hours; Student(s) is/are participating in a rigorous academic program and will be expected to maintain academic progress and to demonstrate desirable work habits. Failure to maintain academic progress may result in Student(s) being placed on academic probation, and/or grade retention; Student(s)’ failure to follow Lincoln Academy rules may lead to behavioral probation and/or dismissal from the school; Homework is a regular requirement for every Student, and Parent(s) will respond to classroom communications, as requested; Lincoln Academy cannot release Student(s) to the custody of anyone not listed on the Student Information Card (aka Emergency Card). Parent(s) must notify the school in advance if anyone not so listed is to pick up Student(s); Lincoln Academy depends on the participation and support of its families. Parent(s) are expected to attend back-to-school night and parent-teacher conferences, and should try to attend other school programs, meetings and activities as feasible.
